May 1	DEADLINE to submit Statement of Intent to Register at UCI (SIR)	Submit your Statement of Intent to Register, with your Acceptance of Admission Fee, and your Statement of Legal Residence (if applicable) via the UCI Applicant Portal .
May 1*	DEADLINE to submit on-campus housing application	Submit your online on-campus housing application (and processing fee). For more information, visit http://housing.uci.edu/apply/How_To_Apply.html * Your SIR must be submitted before you can apply for on-campus housing. May 1	DEADLINE to respond to your Campuswide Honors Collegium Invitation	Respond to your Campuswide Honors Collegium invitation via the UCI Applicant Portal . We hope you will accept!
May 1	Financial Aid and Scholarships priority DEADLINE	Priority deadline for UCI to receive all required supporting documents to complete students' financial aid applications.
CANCELLED	The University of California Analytical Writing Placement Exam (AWPE) has been cancelled.	All Campuswide Honors students must satisfactorily complete the University of California Entry Level Writing Requirement <u>before</u> enrolling in honors courses if at all possible. Students who have not completed this requirement in some other way will be contacted by UCI with information on other opportunities to satisfy Entry Level Writing. June 15	Check for your assignment for <u>MANDATORY</u> summer orientation (SPOP)	Summer orientation is required for all UCI first-year students and includes academic advising, program planning, and enrollment in classes. <u>Campuswide Honors students will be automatically assigned to the first and second sessions of the Student Parent Orientation Program in order to preserve priority enrollment.</u> For more information: www.orientation.uci.edu .
Dates TBA	Take applicable UCI Placement Tests	You are strongly encouraged to take applicable placement tests <u>prior</u> to attending summer orientation so that you will be appropriately placed in classes when you register. Placement tests will be online. For more information about registration and testing, see www.testingcenter.uci.edu .
July 1	<u>DEADLINE</u> to submit official final transcripts	<u>All</u> official final transcripts (high school and college) must be received by the Office of Admissions BY July 1 if at all possible. July 15	Official test scores are <u>DUE</u>	All final official test scores (SAT, ACT, AP, IB) must be received by UCI Admissions BY July 15 if at all possible. For more information: https://admissions.uci.edu/apply/fall20.php
As soon as possible this summer—before SPOP	Complete and attend <u>MANDATORY</u> Campuswide Honors summer advising	You are required to be advised by Campuswide Honors during the summer before attending SPOP 1 or 2. Advising will consist of a series of online modules and resources as well as live webinar. More information will be emailed to you in June.
Mid-July SPOP1: July 13-14 SPOP2: July 17-18 (tentative)	Complete and attend <u>MANDATORY</u> UCI Student Parent Orientation Program (SPOP)	Summer orientation is required for all UCI first-year students and includes academic advising and program planning throughout the summer. Enrollment in classes will occur during your assigned SPOP. <u>Campuswide Honors students will be automatically assigned to the first and second sessions of the Student Parent Orientation Program in order to preserve priority enrollment.</u> For more information: www.orientation.uci.edu

Sept. 15*	<u>DEADLINE</u> to pay fees for Fall Quarter	If fees are not paid on the due date, courses will be dropped and financial penalties incurred. NOTE: <u>NOT</u> A POSTMARK DEADLINE. * <i>Must be completed prior to close of business day. If paying at Central Cashier, by 4:00 p.m. PT. If paying online, prior to 5:00 p.m. PT.</i>
Sept. 25-27 <i>Dates are tentative</i>	Move in to residence halls	Housing and roommate assignments will be emailed by the second week of Sept. for students living in on-campus housing.
